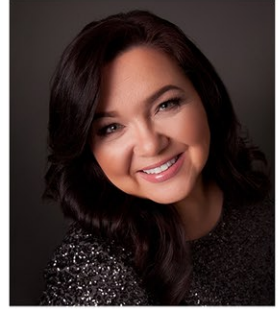

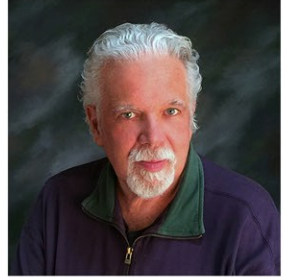

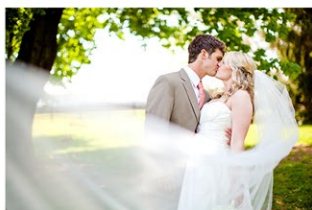


“The Business of Blogging & the Power of Posing”
