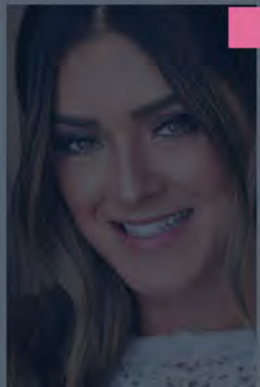

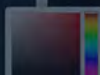

This is when his love for the art became an obsession. Tim spent the next few years learning from the best, so he could create a legacy for others, the one thing he did not possess himself.

Mr. Cameron has received many Kodak Gallery Awards, Fuji Masterpiece Awards, many Courts of Honor and the George H. Hastings Memorial Award. Tim is a Past President and 20 year board member of New Hampshire Professional Photographers Association, where he has earned the Distinguished Colleague of Photography Degree and is a recipient of National Award. Tim is a member of PPA's Certification Team, Councilor from NH and along time volunteer at PPA's Imaging USA. Mr. Cameron educational programs include; Family Portraits on Location, Pets and Commercial Photography.

Ella Putney Carlson, M. Photog.

Ella Putney Carlson has a master of fine arts degree from the New Hampshire Institute of Art and has earned professional photography degrees including Master Photographer, Master Artist, and Educational Associate. Her fine art composites and photography have won multiple Kodak Gallery Awards and Fuji Masterpiece Awards as well as Photographer of the Year awards internationally and in her own state. She has been a PPA Photographer of the Year 9 times in 9 years of competition, including Diamond Photographer of the Year in both 2015 and 2016. She has been teaching digital imaging with Photoshop at the University of Mass, Lowell since the late 1990's.



Ella's art has been exhibited in the Danforth Museum, Artistry Gallery in Vermont, New Hampshire Institute of Art, Vermont Center for Photography, Arts League of Lowell (MA), DeCordova Museum, Cove Gallery (Gloucester, MA), the Professional Photographers of America International Exhibition. Madonna attended the NH Police Academy's Photography Photography for Law Enforcement School and has served as the Department Photographer for the Bedford Fire Department since 2002. Madonna also works with the Bedford Police Department doing photography when needed. She is a certified photographer for crime scene, structure fire, motor vehicle accidents, arson, etc.

Madonna received her judges training at the PPA Judges Workshop. She is an approved PPA International Print Competition (IPC) Juror. Madonna is the first female PPA Approved Juror in New Hampshire. Madonna is currently serving as Immediate Past President for New Hampshire Professional Photographers Association.

This course will cover what you need to know about how to safely handle your client's newest family member. Bailey will discuss the tools and tricks she uses to keep the baby safe, asleep, and happy. She will go over her verbiage and procedures to prepare the client for the portrait session. Bailey will take you through her Newborn work flow with a model. Showing you wrapping techniques and basket prop poses, while demonstrating lighting and angles. The class will leave you with the skills to even capture images of awake and difficult newborns.

After completion of Hallmark Institute of Photography in 2002, Bailey immediately found employment with Prestige Portraits (LTNSS). Where she moved up ranks to management and trainer. She traveled and taught lighting, posing and more in RI, MA, CT, NJ, and NY. During this time, she also managed 12 road photographers, created training manuals, captured the images for the regional SR marketing brochures, and other literature used within the RI territory. Bailey was also the lead photographer on the USAFA account and spent on average 4 months out of the year living and working in Colorado Springs.

In 2013 Bailey left Liferouch and had a second child while officially opening a commercial space of her own in Coventry, RI. The studio started out offering mainly wedding and family portraiture. Bailey Re-branded her studio in 2014 as specializing in Newborn portraits.

Bailey is on the PPARI board in 2017. Bailey is currently their website, social media presence and now their print chair for 2019. Bailey is also the state Director on the board with PPANE. In 2018 she earned her Certification with PPA.

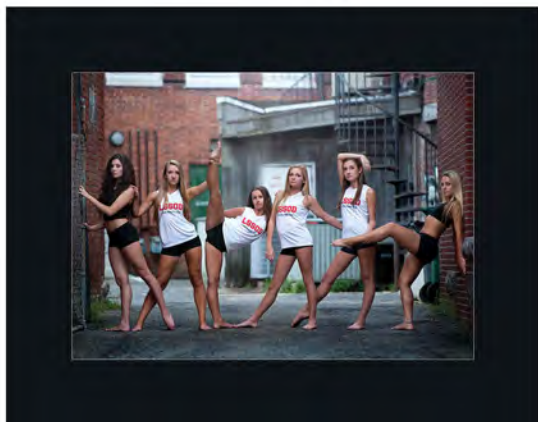
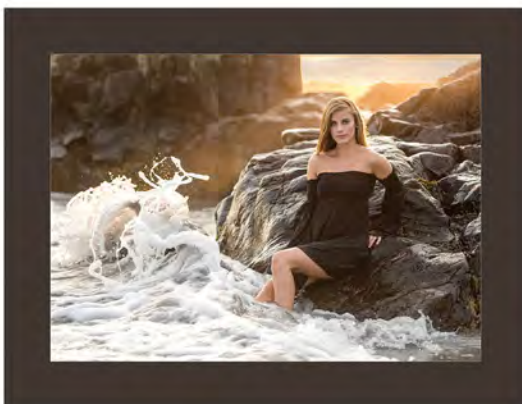
Presidents Cup Recipients

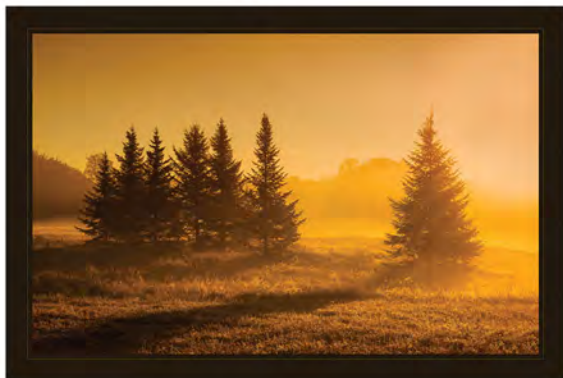

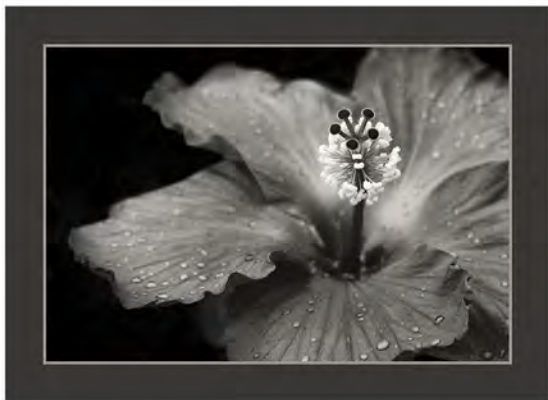

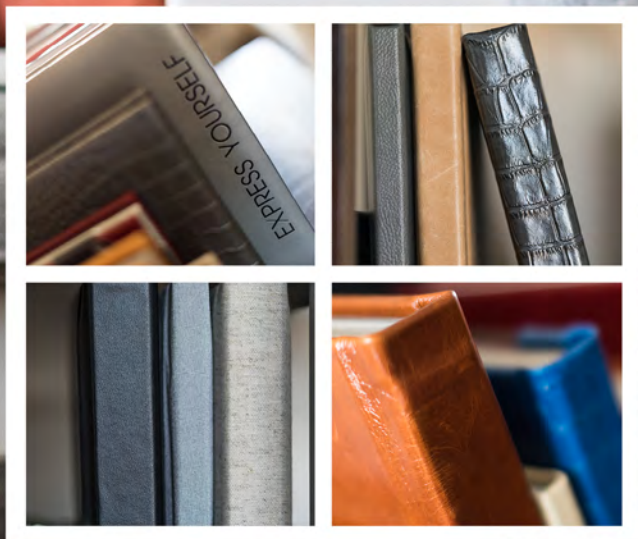
